What is knowledge? To know something true and fact. Word science – understanding knowledge

Hosea 6:4 my people are destroyed from lack of **knowledge**, "Because you have rejected knowledge...

Proverbs 18:15 An intelligent heart acquires **knowledge**, and the ear of the wise seeks knowledge.

Colossians 2:3 in whom (Jesus) are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and **knowledge.**

Knowledge points to God

Knowledge of God is all around us but we take it for granted.

Genesis 1:1 In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth.

Sun – is made of hydrogen and helium, diameter 1.4 million miles. 1.3 million earths will fill the sun.

Temperature of the sun is about 5600 C

Whole solar system orbits around the sun at 828,000 km/hr, takes 230 million years to complete the orbit.

Creation points to the Creator

Psalm 19 The heavens declare the glory of God,

- and the sky above proclaims his handiwork.
- 2 Day to day pours out speech,
- and night to night reveals knowledge.
- 3 There is no speech, nor are there words,
- whose voice is not heard.
- 4 Their voice goes out through all the earth,
- and their words to the end of the world.
- In them he has set a tent for the sun,

Knowledge points to God

Earth – Rotates around the axis about 1000 km/hr.

Rotates around the sun at the speed of 67,000 mph.

Who holds the universe?

Psalm 139

- O Lord, you have searched me and known me!
- 2 You know when I sit down and when I rise up; you discern my thoughts from afar.
- 3 You search out my path and my lying down and are acquainted with all my ways.
- 4 Even before a word is on my tongue, behold, O Lord, you know it altogether.

Psalm 139:4-6,13-14
